

7 Competition rules

Unless otherwise stated within these regulations, the competition will be conducted in accordance with the:

• IWUF Wushu Sanda Competition Rules & Judging Methods (2017)

In the event of language discrepancies in the Rules and Methods, the English text shall prevail.

7.1 Sanda competition

The competition will utilize the single-knockout method. However, if the number of athletes in a given weight class is three (3) or fewer, a round-robin competition method will be adopted.

Following arrival and accreditation, Sanda athletes will undergo an initial weigh-in and drawing-of-lots as stipulated in the schedule.

7.2 Sanda Requirements

Each athlete must provide two (2) sets of competition uniforms: one (1) blue set and one (1) red set.

Each athlete must provide their own mouth guard, jockstrap, and instep guard.

Gloves and protective equipment will be NOT provided by the Organizing Committee.

7.3 Clothing Requirements for Awards Ceremony

Medalists are expected to attend the Awards Ceremony in their national team uniforms; however, they are permitted to attend the ceremony wearing competition uniforms should the ceremony take place immediately after the competition.

Athletes are expected to take off caps/hats during the ceremony.

Athletes and officials are not allowed to take any religious symbols to or onto the podium.

7.4 Compliance Check at Roll Call Center

Uniform and weapons checks will be conducted at the Roll Call Center in accordance with stated regulations and requirements. Uniforms and weapons checks are conducted by the Chief Register and the Roll-Call Officials as stipulated in the Rules. Non-compliance may be subject to disqualification from the competition.

All athletes are required to attend the initial roll call thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of their competition event, and be present for all subsequent roll calls. Failure to be present for three (3) roll calls will result in forfeit.

8 Placing and awards

8.1 Placing

8.2 Awards ceremony

Athletes having won a medal are required to attend the Awards Ceremony to receive their medals in person. In case a medalist is unable to attend the ceremony for a valid reason, his/her medal may be presented to an official of the relevant delegation. Absence without a valid reason will forfeit the right to receive a medal.

Team leaders, coaches, doctors, observers, and members must stay at the designated area and are prohibited from entering the awarding platform area and/or interrupting the Awards Ceremony.

If fewer than 3 (three) athletes participate in a given event, no Awards Ceremony will be held for that event, however, athletes will still be ranked and receive awards accordingly.

Athletes having won a medal are advised to observe and follow the IWUF Awards Ceremony Procedure.

8.3 Participation certificates

All members of each Team, including team leaders, coaches, doctors, and athletes will receive a 1st French Sanda Open participation certificate.

The Team leader is required to collect the participation certificates for their Team from the Organizing Committee at the designated Results & Certificate Center.

9 Registration

9.1 Preliminary Entry

The Preliminary Entry Form must state the number of athletes as accurately as possible taking part in the events so that the LOC may prepare the organization of the event accordingly. The Preliminary Entry Form and formal request for a French visa invitation letter must reach the French Kungfu Wushu Committee Secretariat by email (secretariat@cnwushu.fr) no later than November 14th, 2019.

9.2 Final Entry

All final entries must be submitted through the French Kungfu Wushu Committee Online Registration

The deadline for final entry submission through the online system is on November 14th, 2019. Each Team is required to print a copy of the submitted entry and present it during accreditation upon arrival in France.

All sections of the online entry must be completed in full

9.3 Post-deadline Entries or Changes

After the final entry deadline, any information change (including late entry) will be handled as follows:

- Late entries are subject to the approval of the French Kungfu Wushu Committee and, if accepted, are subject to a late-entry fee of € 100 per athlete.
- Replacing athletes is subject to approval of the French Kungfu Wushu Committee and, if accepted, is subject to a replacement fee of € 100 per athlete.
- Changes due to incorrect or missing registration information are subject to the approval of the French Kungfu Wushu Committee and, if accepted, are subject to a change fee of € 100.
- The above fees must be paid in cash to the French Kungfu Wushu Committee Secretariat before the start of the competition.

10 Arrival and accreditation

10.1 Arrival

All Teams are required to register with the 1st French Sanda Open Organizing Committee at the designated Accreditation Center no later than 09:30am on Saturday November 23rd, 2019.

10.2 Accreditation

Accreditation Center will open at 08:30 on Saturday November 23rd, 2019.

Upon arrival at the Accreditation Center, the Team leader is required to complete the following process with the Organizing Committee:

1.	Present each team member's passport
2.	Submit a paper copy of a signed and stamped Final Entry Form and confirm the registration information
3.	Submit valid Medical Certificates (Appendix 4)
4.	Submit valid life and liability insurance certificates
5.	Submit the signed Wavier of Liabilities (Appendix 5)
6.	Pay the relevant participation fees in full (if applicable)
7.	Pay the relevant penalty fees in full (if applicable)
8.	Sign and confirm all the above items are completed

Accreditation cards will be given to the team leader upon completion of the accreditation process. Accreditation cards must be worn during all official 1st French Sanda Open events.

The training schedule will be announced after accreditation has concluded.

11 Technical meeting

The Technical Meeting will take place at 09:45 on Saturday November 23rd, 2019. Each Team should send 1-3 representatives to attend the meeting.

The Technical Meeting content will be presented as follows:

- Event Logistics Information (Organizing Committee representatives)
- Event Technical Details (French Kungfu Wushu Committee Technical Committee representatives)
- Other matters

12 Drawing of lots

The Drawing of Lots will be conducted by representatives of the Organizing Committee and the French Kungfu Wushu Committee Technical Committee on Saturday November 23rd, 2019.

Each Team should send one to two (1-2) representatives to attend the sessions.

The French Kungfu Wushu Committee Technical Committee will draw lots on behalf of Teams if the Team representatives are absent from the session.

13 Weigh-in

The official weigh-in for all Sanda athletes will take place from 08:30 on Saturday November 23rd, 2019. Furthermore, Sanda athletes must attend a weigh-in on each day they participate in competition (specific time and places for each weigh-in will be announced accordingly). Accreditation cards and passports must be presented at each weigh-in session. A Sanda athlete's failure to attend any required weigh-in will result in his/her disqualification from the competition.

14 Jury of appeals

The Jury of Appeals and appeals procedures shall be subject to the relevant provisions of IWUF Wushu Taolu Competition Rules & Judging Methods (Excerpt) 2019 and IWUF Wushu Sanda Competition Rules & Judging Methods (2017).

15 Doping control

Doping control will be conducted during the 1st French Sanda Open in accordance with the requirements of the International Olympic Committee (IOC) and World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA), and will follow the procedure prescribed in the IWUF Anti-Doping Rules (2015). The exact number of tests will be decided by the French Kungfu Wushu Committee.
