
"Georges Carpentier sporthall" is a multi-use indoor sporting arena that is located in the 13th arrondissement of Paris.

7 Competition rules

Unless otherwise stated within these regulations, the competition will be conducted in accordance with the:

- IWUF Wushu Sanda Competition Rules & Judging Methods (2017)
- AFWK Sanda Light Competition Rules 2021

In the event of language discrepancies in the Rules and Methods, the English text shall prevail.

7.1 Sanda competition

The competition will utilize the single-knockout method. However, if the number of athletes in each weight class is three (3) or fewer, a round-robin competition method will be adopted.

Following arrival and accreditation, Sanda athletes will undergo an initial weigh-in and drawing-of-lots as stipulated in the schedule.

7.2 Sanda Requirements

Each athlete must provide two (2) sets of competition uniforms:

- One (1) blue set
- One (1) red set.
- Their own mouth guard, jockstrap, and instep guard.
- Gloves and protective equipment blue set
- Gloves and protective equipment red set

7.3 Clothing Requirements for Awards Ceremony

Medallists are expected to attend the Awards Ceremony in their competition uniforms.

Athletes are expected to take off caps/hats during the ceremony.

Athletes and officials are not allowed to take any religious symbols to or onto the podium.

7.4 Compliance Check at Roll Call Center

Uniform and weapons checks will be conducted at the Roll Call Center in accordance with stated regulations and requirements. Uniforms and protective equipments checks are conducted by the Chief Register and the Roll-Call Officials as stipulated in the Rules. Non-compliance may be subject to disqualification from the competition.

All athletes are required to attend the initial roll call thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of their competition event and be present for all subsequent roll calls. Failure to be present for three (3) roll calls will result in forfeit.

8 Placing and awards

8.1 Placing

	1 st place	Gold Medal & Certificate

8.2 Awards ceremony

Athletes having won a medal are required to attend the Awards Ceremony to receive their medals in person. In case a medallist is unable to attend the ceremony for a valid reason, his/her medal may be presented to an official of the relevant delegation. Absence without a valid reason will forfeit the right to receive a medal.

Team leaders, coaches, doctors, observers, and members must stay at the designated area and are prohibited from entering the awarding platform area and/or interrupting the Awards Ceremony.

Athletes having won a medal are advised to observe and follow the IWUF Awards Ceremony Procedure.

8.3 Participation certificates

All members of each Team, (only athletes) will receive a 2nd French Sanda Open participation certificate.

Each athlete is required to collect the participation certificates for their Team from the Organizing Committee at the designated Results & Certificate Center.

9 Registration

9.1 Preliminary & Final Entry

The Preliminary Entry Form and formal request for a French visa invitation letter must reach the French Wushu Kungfu Association Secretariat by email (secretariat@wushuffk.fr) no later than October 24th, 2021.

All final entries must be submitted through the French Wushu Kungfu Association Online Registration

Each Team is required to print a copy of the submitted entry and present it during accreditation upon arrival in France.

All sections of the online entry must be completed in full

9.2 Registration fees

€50 (fifty euros) per athlete

By entering through the French Wushu Kungfu Association Online Registration system, you, your parent / guardian if under 18 and your coach have agreed and understood the competition rules and regulations.

9.3 Payment Methods

9.4 Post-deadline Entries or Changes

After the final entry deadline, any information change (including late entry) will be handled as follows:

- Late entries are subject to the approval of the French Kungfu Wushu Association and, if accepted, are subject to a late-entry fee of € 100 per athlete.
- Replacing athletes is subject to approval of the French Kungfu Wushu Association and, if accepted, is subject to a replacement fee of € 100 per athlete.
- Changes due to incorrect or missing registration information are subject to the approval of the French Wushu Kungfu Association and, if accepted, are subject to a change fee of € 100.
- The above fees must be paid in cash to the French Wushu Kungfu Association Secretariat before the start of the competition.

10 Arrival and accreditation

10.1 Arrival

All Teams are required to register with the 2nd French Sanda Open Organizing Committee at the designated Accreditation Center no later than 09:30am on Saturday November 27th, 2021.

10.2 Accreditation

Accreditation Center will open at 08:30 on Saturday November 27th, 2021.

Upon arrival at the Accreditation Center, the Team leader is required to complete the following process with the Organizing Committee:

1.	Present each team member's passport
2.	Submit a paper copy of a signed and stamped Final Entry Form and confirm the registration information
3.	Submit the signed Wavier of Liabilities (Appendix 5)

Accreditation cards will be given to each athlete upon completion of the accreditation process. Accreditation cards must be worn during all official 2nd French Sanda Open events. The training schedule will be announced after accreditation has concluded.

11 Technical meeting

The Technical Meeting will take place at 09:45 on Saturday November 27th, 2021. Each Team should send 1-3 representatives to attend the meeting.

The Technical Meeting content will be presented as follows:

- Event Logistics Information (Organizing Committee representatives)
- Event Technical Details (French Wushu Kungfu Association Technical Committee representatives)
- Other matters

12 Weigh-in

The official weigh-in for all Sanda athletes will take place from 08:30 on Saturday November 27th, 2021. Furthermore, Sanda athletes must attend a weigh-in on each day they participate in competition (specific time and places for each weigh-in will be announced accordingly). Accreditation cards and passports must be presented at each weigh-in session. A Sanda athlete's failure to attend any required weigh-in will result in his/her disqualification from the competition.
